Role Description: Dr. Martínez leads the community education component in Epl-Net. Her team develops COVID-19 health promotion and prevention interventions.






Dra. Kamalich Muñiz-Rodríguez, MPH, DrPH


Gina M. Sánchez Cruz, BS, MHA, MS, DrPh(c)






Natalia Martínez-Torres, BS, Sec. Ed. Cert., MPH(c) Research Assistant - Period 1
